He left behind his wife and three daughters, Isabella, Annalise, and Allyson. Greg grew up on the family farm near Vilna. He attended Vilna school and was active in many sports and participated in Ukrainian dancing in Vilna. He liked to play hockey, slow pitch ball and curling. He was involved in his community, member of the Vilna Curling Club, Hamlin Hall, Vilna Fish & Game and volunteered for the Vilna Ag Society. Greg attended NAIT and became a master electrician. He completed his apprenticeship with local companies and then started his own business, Haywire Electric. He worked around the areas of Smoky Lake and St. Paul and was proud to be an active tradesperson.

Greg was actively involved in agriculture and loved rural life. Greg wanted to continue to grow the family farm but he also realized the importance of further education. A scholarship of \$1000.00 in his memory would assist other individuals to help with the expense of furthering their education.

They must have at least completed their second year of their program and have graduated from high school in the County of Smoky Lake or the County of St. Paul. ## GREG FLONDRA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

### Requirements for College Students Applicants:

1. Proof of completion of first year or more with hours from a credited college or trade school in a certified apprenticeship program.
2. Must of lived OR graduated from High School in the County of Smoky Lake or County of St. Paul.
3. Applicants with volunteer and/or community involvement within your area is preferred. Please include any community activities, groups, or organizations you are involved in on the application.
4. **INCLUDE A MINIMUM 300 WORDS ESSAY TITLED: "WHAT DOES COMMUNITY MEAN TO ME?"**
5. Feel free to include any other information you think is important for the consideration of your application.

NOTE: All applications and essays will be scored on a rubric scale to determine the winner. One of the graders is not from the community and is considered impartial. The rubric asks graders to mark applicants based on how well they display certain attributes.
